

Categories & Criteria - 2006 DOTY Awards

- Please review the 15 categories for the 2006 DOTY Award program. Of special note: A new category 10 has been created for redesigned dolls. Categories 1-9 are for manufacturers, and categories 10-15 are for artists.
- An artist or manufacturer cannot win more than two Industry's Choice Awards in the same category.

Manufacturer Categories

1. Collectible Baby Doll

- Can be produced in any medium.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

2. Collectible Fashion Doll

- Can be produced in any medium.
- Additional outfits for doll should be offered separately.
- Doll must be 18 inches and smaller.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

3. Collectible Vinyl/Plastic Doll, Less than \$150

- Doll's head must be composed of vinyl or any similar plastic compound; body and limbs can be made of any substance.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

4. Collectible Vinyl/Plastic Doll, Over \$150

- Doll's head must be composed of vinyl or any similar plastic compound; body and limbs can be made of any substance.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

5. Collectible Porcelain Doll

- Doll's head must be composed of porcelain; body and limbs can be made of any substance.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

6. Collectible Miniature Doll, 8 inches or less

- May be made of any substance.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

7. Collectible Manufacturer's Artist Doll, Less than \$150

- Manufacturers submitting the entry must recognize the artist as such.
- Artist's name must be associated with the doll, box, or tag, and with the doll's advertising and marketing campaigns.
- Artist must have sculpted the doll's head.
- Dolls can be made of any medium.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

8. Collectible Manufacturer's Artist Doll, \$150-\$350

- Manufacturers submitting the entry must recognize the artist as such.
- Artist's name must be associated with the doll, box, or tag, and with the doll's advertising and marketing campaigns.
- Artist must have sculpted the doll's head.
- Dolls can be made of any medium.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

9. Collectible Manufacturer's Artist Doll, Over \$350

- Manufacturers submitting the entry must recognize the artist as such.
- Artist's name must be associated with the doll, box, or tag, and with the doll's advertising and marketing campaigns.
- Artist must have sculpted the doll's head.
- Dolls can be made of any medium.
- Minimum edition of dolls produced and offered for sale worldwide must exceed 100.

Artist Categories

Entrants for the following six categories must meet the following criteria:

--Minimum edition of 2-100 in categories 11, 12, and 13. Only one-a-kinds can be entered in categories 14 and 15.

--Doll's head, body, and limbs can be of any substance in all artist categories.

--All dolls must be produced and commercially available by November 1, 2006.

10. Redesign Doll

--Can be in any medium

--Can be any kind of manufactured doll but the manufacturer must be identified.

--Limited to 10 or less.

11. Artist Doll, Less than \$1000

12. Artist Doll, \$1000-\$2000

13. Artist Doll, Over \$2000

14. One-Of-A-Kind Dolls, Less than \$1500

15. One-Of-A-Kind Dolls, Over \$1500
